

Christopher Robertson - Director Policy and Legislation, National Registration and Accreditation Implementation Project

As Director for Policy and Legislation for National Registration and Accreditation Chris has led the development of final policy positions and two stages of national legislation on behalf of all Australian governments to implement the 2008 Council of Australian Governments agreement to establish the national scheme.

Previously, Chris has worked across various clinical, health management and policy roles in Victoria, Queensland and nationally. Initially working as a registered nurse Chris specialised in critical care nursing at the Alfred Hospital in Melbourne prior to relocating to Queensland and later moving into nursing and business management roles at the Princess Alexandra Hospital. While completing a commerce and human resource management degree he moved into the Queensland Department of Health working on a range of major change projects. Prior to starting the National registration project Chris was Workforce Director for Southern Area Health Service in Queensland.
